The IBCC is a world-class facility which serves as a focal point for recognition, remembrance, and reconciliation for Bomber Command. The command was instrumental in introducing modern Electronic Warfare into the air environment in WW2. It provides the most comprehensive record of Bomber Command in the world and will be a unique venue for our 50th Anniversary Dinner.
